RE: Proposed Wynn Development and Freedom of Information Request for Public Records

Dear Attorney Mejia,

I am writing to you to follow up on the City of Boston's public records request for information on the proposed Wynn development so that the City of Boston can better understand the Wynn proposal.

The following is a brief overview of the correspondence to date:

- August 9, 2013: The City of Boston sent the City of Everett a public records request so that we can understand the proposed Wynn development;
- August 22, 2013: The City of Boston received the City of Everett's reply letter, provided a cost estimate of \$851.92 for the documents that the City of Boston requested;
- August 22, 2013: the City of Boston sent by certified mail a check payable to the City of Everett for the request amount;
- September 19, 2013: The City of Boston sent a follow up letter, asking for the requested and paid for documents, and/or a time estimate of when to expect the documents;
- September 26, 2013: The City of Everett sent a reply letter stating that Boston should anticipate the documents in approximately three (3) weeks, which would be roughly October 17, 2013.

As stated in the original public records request, the proposed Wynn casino will have significant impacts on the City of Boston, including impacts on our roads, waterways, businesses, visitors, environment and the quality of life of our residents. The City of Boston is seeking to understand these impacts. Now, nearly three (3) months after our initial request, we respectfully request that the City of Everett provide the requested and paid for documents.
