





Reconstruction needs include:



- Regrading and paving
- Striping
- Improving the handicapped parking space
- Replacing the chain link fence
- Repairing the brick wall
- Adding lighting



RENOVATION CONCEPTS

Improvements to the site may include:

- Regrading, paving, and striping
- Adding bollards at the entrance
- Replacing the chain link fence between the parking lot and adjacent property
- Adding four light posts
- Repairing the brick wall and adding a stone cap along the top
- Replacing and enhancing existing plantings
- Repairing the staircase and adding railings
- Upgrading the handicapped parking space in accordance with code



EXISTING CONDITIONS

Reconstruction needs include:

- Addressing drainage
- Regrading and paving
- Striping
- Improving pedestrian connections
- Replacing curbing and increasing greenery throughout the site



RENOVATION CONCEPTS

Improvements to the site may include:

- Regrading, paving, and striping
- Adding tree, shrubs, and grasses throughout the parking lot
- Creating a bioretention basin to treat runoff
- Replacing outdated lighting
- Adding a decorative fence along the street and renovating the sidewalk
- Installing a new chain link fence




Reconstruction needs include:




- Regrading and paving
