

Boston's New Public Innovation Center

at Northern Avenue & Seaport Boulevard, Fan Pier



The Innovation Center will be a hub and home base for entrepreneurs to meet and exchange ideas, to convene programs and events, and to support the innovation economy. It is another example of how Boston successfully leverages private partnerships to further development in the Innovation District.

- The Innovation Center will be active 18 hours a day.
- The Center will include a restaurant as well as critical meeting space for networking and events.
- The Boston Redevelopment Authority will lease the facility for 5 years with the option to renew for another 5 years thereafter.
- Cambridge Innovation Center and affiliates Tim Rowe and Brian Dacey will manage the day to day Innovation Center operations.
- Groundbreaking: April 18, 2012
- Specs: 12,000 sq. ft. facility, including a 3,000 sq. ft. restaurant and 9,000 sq. ft. of meeting and event space.
- Total project cost: \$5.5 M
- The project will create approximately 31 jobs, including 16 construction jobs and 15 permanent jobs.
