

Comments from 1st Public Meeting

- **Pedestrians**
 - **Safe crossings**
- **Pedestrian and vehicles follow same rules**
- **Parking and loading are important**
- **Open Space**
 - **Desire for more**
 - **Improve access**
- **Too much pavement**
- **Organize and improve traffic circulation**
- **Consolidate bus stops**

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



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
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Pedestrian Circulation: Existing

- **Large expanses of pavement disconnect park from commercial edges**




Issues

Opportunities




Opportunities







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

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

Option 1

- **More open space**

- **Loss of significant market/festival space**
- **Corner curb extensions don't feel like part of park**
- **More parking**
