Temporary Food Procedures

- Vendors that sell/serve food/beverage products and processed foods shall be licensed as a temporary food operation for \$30 a day and \$5 for each consecutive day up to 14 days and the group as a whole must request a inspection by the local health department for if serving PHF's, all temporary food applications are attached and the inspectors request are is available at 1010 Mass Ave.
- □ A <u>Temporary Food Permit</u> is needed if the consumer can eat or drink the product you are sampling/selling
- □ Large events (10 vendors or more) have to be coordinated by the coordinator of the event. (**There will be no individual applications accepted**.)
- □ The application **MUST be submitted within 14 days** of the actual event.
- □ The Special Event Application (**if needed**) will be signed off when all applications have been submitted.
- □ All applications must be accompanied by cash, money order or credit card.
