

CALL TO ARTISTS

THE GALLERIES AT BOSTON CITY HALL

Seeking Boston-based artists and arts organizations or groups with members that include Boston-based artists to exhibit in Scollay Square Gallery and the Mayor's Art Gallery during the 2005-6 exhibition season. Scollay Square Gallery is a public space within Boston City Hall located on the 3rd floor adjacent to the Government Center Plaza entrance. The Mayor's Gallery is located on the 5th floor area outside the Mayor's Office.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Preference will be given to Boston-based artists and arts organizations or groups with members that include Boston-based artists that provide an interesting variety of art types.
- Artwork submitted will be juried by the Scollay Square Exhibition Committee.

PLEASE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING

- 6 slides or photographs of representative work to be shown. All slides must be 2" x 2", including the cardboard or plastic mount. Glass slides are not acceptable. Each slide should include: name of artist, arrow indicating image top, and the number of each slide or picture as it corresponds with the slide list.
- Enclosed slide list/description sheet.
- Resume or brief description of your art experiences.
- One-paragraph summary about the type of work you are presenting.
- Please submit a suitable self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) if you would like your proposal/support materials returned to you. (The Mayor's Arts, Tourism & Special Events is not responsible for loss of/or damage to support materials that are not accompanied by suitable SASE)
