

Rabies Vaccine Fee

\$5 dog/cat
\$2 (senior owners)

Dog Licensing Fee

\$6 spayed/neutered
\$17 intact male/female

All pets must be held by a person 18 years or older. Please DO NOT bring cats in a cardboard box or pet adoption box, cats must be in a Vari-kennel or similar pet carrier. Your pet will only get a 3 year rabies vaccine if you can show written proof that (1) the last rabies vaccine was given 9-12 months prior to clinic date or (2) that your pet has had a 3 year rabies vaccine at any point in the past.

Aggressive dogs must be muzzled.

Please DO NOT bring your pet to the rabies clinic on a retractable leash.
