(To avoid potential confusion, the text of your building-permit application should be consistent with the project description given below.) Commission staff will accordingly authorize the execution of the work, attaching any applicable provisos, reflecting the relevant guidelines and precedents.

▶ PLEASE NOTE THAT NO FURTHER CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ISSUED for the applications listed below. The electronic building-permit application as annotated by commission staff will constitute your Certificate of Appropriateness; this will be valid for one year from the date of the hearing. The applicant is required to notify the commission of any project changes; failure to do so may affect the status of the approval.

entry key box in existing locations.

Application 16.1003 BB 314 Marlborough Street: Install two light fixtures and a flush-mounted call box

within the side panels at the entryway; reintroducing a leader and relocating a leader on both sides of the bay window; installing a light fixture at the rear door and on wood posts along the pathway; and installing a flush-mounted

call box within the rear fence.

Application 16.996 BB <u>163 Newbury Street</u>: Replace the deteriorated portions of the wood cornice

featuring a built-in copper gutter to match existing; repair and repaint the frieze white to match existing; and selective replacement of deteriorated

slate shingles on the mansard roof in-kind.
