Dear Attorney Mejia,

I am writing to you to in regards to an outstanding public records request, initiating on August 9, 2013. The public documents requested from the City of Everett will assist the City of Boston - including our residents, businesses and communities – in our understanding and analysis of the proposed Wynn casino development at the former Monsanto Chemical site.

This public records request dates back to August 9, 2013. On August 22, 2013, you received by certified mail the check for the documents in your requested amount of \$851.92. On September 26, 2013, your office stated that Boston should anticipate the requested documents by roughly October 17, 2013. Today, two months after the date you proposed our receipt of the requested documents, we have not received anything. In fact, despite repeated outreach, we have had no reply from your office since September 26, 2013.

Attached hereto, please find the August 9, 2013, public records request and the copy of the certified check. We expect the request documents within seven (7) days.

RE: Proposed Wynn Development and Freedom of Information Request for Public Records

Dear Mayor DeMaria, City Clerk Matarazzo and Keeper of the Records:

As you are aware, the proposed development of the Wynn casino will have significant impacts on the City of Boston, including impacts on our roads, waterways, businesses, visitors, environment, and the quality of life of our residents, with a particularly prominent impact on the Charlestown community. It is of the highest priority that we understand this development and these forceful impacts. But to date our information requests have been ignored and disregarded by the Wynn development. We now turn to you, as fellow public servants, and request information that is so important to our community. This development must be understood. The boundaries of this development must be detailed. The City of Boston's status regarding this development must be particularly and extremely clear.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, and the applicable Massachusetts public records law, the City of Boston is requesting all studies, reports, analysis and information about the proposed Wynn casino, including: (1) all transportation and traffic studies, (2) site plans, (3) the draft Municipal Harbor Plan, as it is critical to the proposed development, (4) all environmental analysis of the site and this development, (5) any documentation on the proposed Redevelopment Authority, (6) documents on the redevelopment of the Broadway area, and documents pertaining to a comprehensive analysis of existing conditions and outlining land acquisitions and dispositions in the proposed Wynn development area, and (7) any and all other relevant information regarding the proposed Wynn development.

If your office is not the keeper of the records for these documents please forward this request to the appropriate City office. If there is a charge associated with this request, please notify me beforehand. If any documents pursuant to this request are not public records please notify me of the applicable exemption.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. Please do not hesitate to contact me should you have any questions.
