

## \$400,000 Transportation & Pedestrian Action Plan

- Establish Existing Conditions for pedestrian, vehicular and bicycle flows & safety
- 2. Identify "Hot Spots" and propose short-term improvements
- 3. Establish 2007 Off-Street Parking Inventory and project trends to 2020
- 4. Recommend Off-Street parking management strategies for residents, commuters and visitors
- 5. Prioritize Right-of-Way reconstruction projects to improve conditions for pedestrians, vehicles and bicycles
- 6. Develop preliminary designs for selected projects for \$12.5 million roadway improvements
- 7. Test projected developments, parking and roadway improvements.
