Upon its receipt, Commission staff will accordingly authorize the execution of the work, attaching any applicable provisos, reflecting the relevant guidelines and precedents.

**14.751 SE: 1 Appleton Street:** Install signage; re-cover 9 existing awnings.

**14.740 SE: 95 Appleton Street:** Reopen existing light well; replace under stoop door and clad steps and walkway to new door in bluestone.

**14.738 SE: 88 Chandler Street:** Replace 7 windows (aluminum); replace existing roof deck & repair existing head house (**visibility must be reviewed by staff for these two items**); replace asphalt shingles at mansard with synthetic slate.

**14.747 SE: 517 Columbus Avenue:** Clean and restore storefront; replace lighting with 5 gooseneck lamps; install signage.

**14.754 SE: 492 Massachusetts Avenue:** Replace rubber roof and associated flashing.

**14.755 SE: 492 Massachusetts Avenue:** Replace existing fire-damaged roof deck; railings to be black, wrought iron (**visibility has been reviewed by staff**).

**14.744 SE: 550 Massachusetts Avenue:** Repair/in-kind replacement of deteriorated wood at fascia and soffit.

**14.743 SE: 503 Shawmut Avenue:** Install storm windows.

**14.749 SE: 514 Tremont Street:** Install signage.

**14.750 SE: 518 Tremont Street:** Install signage.

**14.733 SE: 89 Waltham Street:** Replace 3 windows (wood, must be 2/2).

**14.742 SE: 151 Warren Avenue:** Reopen existing masonry opening; install window.

**14.741 SE: 1 Wellington Street:** Replace 4 windows (aluminum).

**14.739 SE: 18 Wellington Street:** Replace 3 windows (wood).

**14.737 SE: 183 West Brookline Street:** Replace rubber membrane roof and associated flashing; replace 11 windows (wood); install elevator (exempt); install new hvac system (exempt).

**14.745 SE: 223 West Canton Street:** Replace rubber membrane roof and associated flashing; replace existing roof deck (**visibility must be reviewed by staff**).

**14.756 SE: 121 West Newton Street:** Replace 6 windows (wood); remove and store existing iron fence, gate, and windows grates as well as the existing front door while construction is ongoing (will be reinstalled once work is complete); replace shutters (exempt); install rear balconies (exempt); repair masonry front stoop.

**14.735 SE: 140 West Newton Street:** Repair/in-kind replacement of deteriorated wood trim at dormer; replace 3 dormer windows (wood); repair fascia and soffit.

**14.734 SE: 211 West Newton Street:** Replace 1 window (aluminum).
