


WHAT TO EXPECT FROM YOUR BREATHE EASY INSPECTION

Below are a few things to know about your Breathe Easy Inspection:

- Breathe Easy inspections are intended to assist occupants with respiratory ailments by removing code violations that are asthma triggers.
- We try to schedule Inspections at dates and times that work for everyone.
- The inspector will also seek to address all violations, even those not related to respiratory health.
- Inspectors are also required to address poor housekeeping when it contributes to code violations or makes it difficult for owners to correct code violations.
- The inspector will leave a copy of her/his notes at the end of the inspection.
- Occupants are notified of the follow-up (2nd) inspection by mail along with certified copies of the notice of violation that was sent to the owner.
- The doctor or nurse that referred you is continually updated by email as your case progresses.
- Occupants receive written notification when cases are forwarded to Boston Housing Court.
